

Fitting instructions for side panel leather bag for the 650 Twins (part no: 92934 + 92935)


- Remove the right-hand side panel from the bike to give access. Behind here is a plastic cover, this is secured by 3 screws that need removing and these are circled in the image below.




- The cover should now be free to pull forward, and will just require the pull catch for the seat to be unclipped. This should simply push out of position as shown on the image below, to then allow the cover to be removed fully.



- The leather bag can now be put into position, feeding the seat catch through the large hole whilst lining the bag up in position. Using the three screws removed earlier, refit these through the holes in the back of the leather bag to secure in its final position.



- Final fitment with the bag closed shown below.



Optional fitment of the lower cover

- From the original side panel, remove the three screws holding the lower section of the panel.



- Fit this panel in place on the new leather side cover, and secure with the new fasteners provided.
